XVII CIEGL Second Circular Letter – Call for Proposals for Individual Contributions

Bologna, 10 February 2026

Dear Colleagues,

Firstly, we would like to thank those who submitted proposals to organise parallel sessions at the upcoming International Congress of Greek and Latin Epigraphy. This event will take place from Monday, 30 August to Saturday, 4 September 2027 at the Belmeloro complex in Bologna. Following a review of all the proposals, the Scientific Committee has selected 6 Closed Short Panels and 17 Open Long Panels. These panels are in addition to the eight parallel sessions identified by the Scientific Committee of the Congress: we would like to thank our colleagues who have kindly agreed to chair and organise these sessions.

Apart from the 6 Closed Short Panels, which are already complete and organised, we therefore have 25 parallel sessions. A list and description of these sessions can be found on the Congress website (<https://site.unibo.it/epigrafia-greca-latina-bologna/en/panel/>).

You are invited to submit proposals for individual contributions to one of these 25 sessions, or to submit proposals for stand-alone papers on any topic. Each proposal must be in one of the five conference languages (Italian, French, English, Spanish or German) and last 20 minutes. It must include:

- Session number and title; alternatively, you should mark your proposal 'free topic'.
- First and last name of the contributor.
- Email address.
- Affiliated institution.
- Title of the proposal.
- Abstract of the proposal (maximum 3,000 characters including spaces).

Proposals should be sent to Alice Bencivenni at ciegl2027@unibo.it by **30 September 2026**. Following review, the proposals will be forwarded to the chairs of the relevant sessions, who will select the contributions in consultation with the Scientific and Organising Committees. Authors will be notified of the outcome by 30 November 2026.

It will also be possible to submit posters dedicated to presenting projects and research results by responding to the separate call for poster submissions, which will be issued on 30 November 2026, with a deadline of 31 January 2027.

Participants may submit only one proposal each (with the exception of posters).

Due to the high cost of organising this Congress, participants and speakers cannot be exempted from paying registration fees, which will be higher than those for the Bordeaux Congress.
